## Data Protection

Rovers is subject to the provisions of The Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2017 in the holding of, and processing of your personal data (such as the information you have provided in this Registration Form). You have certain rights in connection with your data, and can request at any time copies of the data the Club holds on you if so required. The data held is required purely for Club matters and for player registration purposes (including County FA registration, where your basic details may be shared with the Guernsey Football Association which is also a data controller under the DP Law), may be held on computer or in hard copy format, and will be destroyed when no longer required. In this regard the Club's data controller is the Club Welfare Officer, Brian Horsepool, who will be able to provide advice at any time.

## Social Media Contact Consent Form for U18s

Rovers AC take the safeguarding of under 18s welfare as paramount.

One area of concern is the inappropriate use of Social Media to communicate with U18s. Social Media includes Email, Text, Facebook, Whatsapp, Teamer or any other form of electronic communication.

To minimize the risk to young people The FA / GFA have issued a "Communications & Social Media Policy – Children & Young People"

[Rovers AC fully endorses this policy and the recommendations contained therein, a copy of which can be found in Section 6 of the Guernsey Rovers Code of Conduct. One of the recommendations is that written informed consent needs to be obtained from parents/carers before any form of social media is used to communicate with U18s.

A Squad Administrator responsible for all squad communications has been assigned to each minis, youth and senior squad.

### Communication Methods

The primary form of communication and any additional forms of communication are detailed on the attached form.

Any contact information provided will be kept private, in so much as the communication method allows and will only be used to communicate matters relating to the squad's football activities i.e. training, matches, venue changes, travel plans or any other pertinent information.

All communications will be sent to the entire membership group. At no time will contact be made to a single individual under the age of 18 unless it is in response to a specific request regarding the squad activities.
